Staff News:

Auto Body (Paul Wurster): Several of the restored hoods with designs are on display on our grounds. Students have been completing their online, OSHA training.

Automotive Technology (David Albrecht): Students have also been completing OSHA training. Our 2nd year students are discussing career options and education for employment (EFE).

Computer Networking & Security (Shane Grissinger): Students are working on a joint endeavor with construction trades and assisting with OSHA training with Auto Body, Auto Technology, & Construction Trades. Students also exploring community outreach possibilities.

Construction Trades Technology (Jeff Finn): Students participated in a construction skills challenge on our grounds utilizing tools, boards, & ropes (teams of 3). Students completing OSHA training. Students and staff are planning the “1st Annual Construction Trades Alumni Cookout.” Students are building Construction Trades Learning Centers and a Construction Trades in-house Manufactured Home Facility.

Cooperative Education (Annamarie Pintozzi): All 5 students in the program have been placed in a number of different work-based learning environments. The job placements including dairy farming, crop and livestock farming, auto body repair, property management, and auto parts sales and customer service.

Restaurant Management & Culinary Science (Chef Annamarie Pintozzi): Students have been working on safety and sanitation in addition to a culinary cultural project. Some of these items will be served at the CTE Academy Open House. The students will also be working on desserts for the Elizabeth Nursing Home for September Birthdays. This will be a monthly on-going project to build their baking skills.

Early Childhood Education (Stacy Kloss): Little Learners (ages 3-5) will begin the school year today, September 4th. Early Childhood students have been preparing for two (2) weeks.

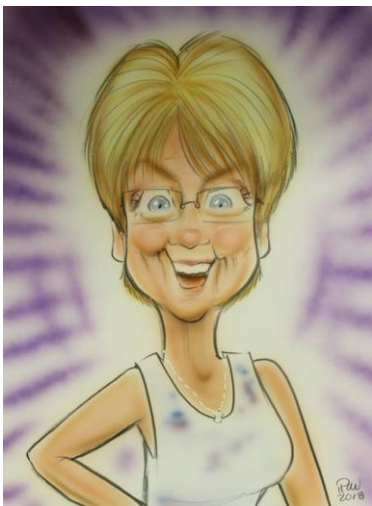
